AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO BE USED IN THE ENFORCEMENT AND COLLECTION OF INCREASED PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice for the 1991-92 fiscal year the sum of \$184,987, to establish and support two new attorney positions, one new paralegal position and one new secretarial position, to be used in the enforcement and collection of the increased penalties established for violations of the Occupational Safety and Health Act.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Labor for the Occupational Safety and Health Act Review Board for the 1991-92 fiscal year the sum of \$58,912, to establish and support a new paralegal position and to cover the increased legal fees necessary because of the increased penalties established for violations of the Occupational Safety and Health Act.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
