A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO APPOINT A "COMPOSER-
LAUREATE FOR THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA."

Whereas, music has had an important place in North Carolina culture; and

Whereas, this State has produced many composers of music of lasting value;

and

Whereas, there is a need to recognize the contributions of these composers;

Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Governor of North Carolina may appoint a distinguished living composer as "Composer-Laureate for the State of North Carolina."

Sec. 2. Any person appointed "Composer-Laureate for the State of North Carolina" shall be appointed for life but may voluntarily resign at any time.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
