A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE EASTERN MUSIC FESTIVAL TO
3	SUPPORT ACTIVITIES COMMEMORATING THE THIRTIETH
4	ANNIVERSARY SEASON OF THE FESTIVAL.
5	Whereas, the Eastern Music Festival is an arts, education, and tourism
6	resource that offers opportunities for students and audiences throughout the State; and
7	Whereas, the Eastern Music Festival has presented its programs for 30 years
8	on the Guilford College Campus, producing concerts, housing and feeding students and
9	professional musicians, and offering instruction in its classroom facilities; and
10	Whereas, the Eastern Music Festival has regularly been selected as one of the
11	top 20 tourist attractions in the South by the Southeast Tourist Society of Georgia; and
12	also recognized by the Christian Science Monitor as one of the top six festivals in the
13	United States; and
14	Whereas, the Eastern Music Festival attracts both national and international
15	attention and offers scholarships specifically for North Carolina students, foreign
16	students, and minority students; Now, therefore,
17	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
18	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Eastern Music
19	Festival, Inc., of Greensboro the sum of \$30,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year to support
20	the activities commemorating the thirtieth anniversary of the Eastern Music Festival.
21	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
