1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION TO CHARGE
3 A FEE FOR DRUG TESTING AS A CONDITION OF PROBATION OR
4 PAROLE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 15A-1343(b1)(7) reads as rewritten:

7 "(7) Submit at reasonable times to warrantless searches by a probation
8 officer of his person and of his vehicle and premises while he is
9 present, for purposes specified by the court and reasonably related to
10 his probation supervision, but the probationer may not be required to
11 submit to any other search that would otherwise be unlawful.
12 Whenever the warrantless search consists of testing for the presence of
13 illegal drugs, the probationer may also be required to reimburse the
14 Department of Correction for the actual cost of drug screening and
15 drug testing."

16 Sec. 2. G.S. 15A-1374(b)(11) reads as rewritten:

17 "(11) Submit at reasonable times to searches of his person by a parole
18 officer for purposes reasonably related to his parole supervision. The
19 Commission may not require as a condition of parole that the parolee
20 submit to any other searches that would otherwise be unlawful.
21 Whenever the search consists of testing for the presence of illegal
22 drugs, the parolee may also be required to reimburse the Department
23 of Correction for the actual cost of drug testing and drug screening."

1 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
