A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SUMMIT HOUSE, A COMMUNITY-  
BASED RESIDENTIAL ALTERNATIVE TO INCARCERATION FOR  
MOTHERS AND PREGNANT WOMEN CONVICTED OF NONVIOLENT  
CRIMES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
Crime Control and Public Safety for the 1991-92 fiscal year the sum of \$250,000 to  
support the program at Summit House, a community-based residential alternative to  
incarceration for mothers and pregnant women convicted of nonviolent crimes. Summit  
House shall report quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental  
Operations on the expenditure of State appropriations and on the effectiveness of the  
program, including information on the number of clients served, the number of clients  
who have their probation revoked, and the number of clients who successfully complete  
the program while housed at Summit House.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
