A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ROCKY MOUNT TO  
GRANT AUTHORITY FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF NONTAX REVENUES  
FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 938 of the 1963 Session Laws, being the Charter of the  
City of Rocky Mount, as amended is further amended to add subparagraph (ee) to  
Section 10 to read:

"(ee) To appropriate annually from the funds of the City derived from sources other  
than ad valorem taxation, funds (i) to local school administrative units for the purpose  
of enhancing the educational opportunity of students residing within the corporate  
limits, and (ii) to the Nash-Rocky Mount School Administrative Unit as required by  
legislation providing for the merger and consolidation of the school administrative units  
in Nash County and the City of Rocky Mount."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
