Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring: 4 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study issues relating 5 to the Emergency Medical Services Act of 1973 in order to: Determine whether the Emergency Medical Services Act of 1973 (1) provides the State with the most integrated and coordinated approach to emergency medical care; Determine whether all residents of the State have access to high 10 (2) quality emergency medical services care; Determine what impact the reduction in federal assistance has had in (3) emergency medical care in North Carolina; Determine whether the current structure of providing emergency 14 (4) medical services in North Carolina serves the public in the best, most 15 comprehensive manner; and 16 Determine whether the recommendations of the National Highway 17 (5) Traffic Safety Administration's "Assessment of Emergency Medical 18 Services in North Carolina" should be implemented. 19

Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report,

including any legislative recommendations, to the 1991 General Assembly, Regular

Session 1992, and may make a final report to the 1993 General Assembly.
