**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR  
THE EMPLOYMENT OF SAFETY AND HEALTH INSPECTORS AND  
RELATED SUPPORT STAFF.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Labor the sum of four million two hundred twenty-five thousand one hundred sixty-four dollars (\$4,225,164) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the employment of 80 safety and health inspectors and related support to meet federal OSHA benchmarks for the North Carolina Occupational Safety and Health program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
