A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO  
2 STUDY THE NEED FOR LICENSING AND REGULATION OF ALL-TERRAIN  
3 VEHICLES ON THE HIGHWAYS OF THE STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the need for  
7 licensing, testing, and safety requirements for drivers of all-terrain vehicles. In its study  
8 the Commission may consider the need for helmet and vehicle equipment requirements,  
9 training programs, dealer requirements, penalties, and operating requirements for all-  
10 terrain vehicles on the streets and highways of the State.

11 Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to  
12 the 1993 General Assembly, 1994 Regular Session, and may make a final report of its  
13 findings and recommendations to the 1995 General Assembly.

14 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative  
15 Research Commission the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1993-94  
16 fiscal year for the study authorized by Section 1 of this act.

17 Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
