Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the need for a residential property disclosure act. Such an act would require owners of residential property to provide purchasers of the property with either (i) a residential property disclaimer statement providing that the owner makes no representations or warranties as to the condition of the property; or (ii) a residential property disclosure statement disclosing those defects in the property of which the owner has actual knowledge.

Sec. 2. The Commission may report its findings and recommendations to the 1995 General Assembly, and may make an interim report to the 1994 Regular Session of the 1993 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
