The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
Section 1. G.S. 75-30 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:	
"(b1) No unsolicited telephone call may be made by the use of an automatic dialing	
and recorded message player prior to 9:00 a.m. or after 6:00 p.m. East	·
or Daylight Saving Time, whichever is in effect. Provided, howev	er, this subsection
shall not apply to a public utility as defined in G.S. 62-3(23)a.6."	
Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1993, and applies to offenses	
committed on or after that date.
