A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ALLOW STATE EMPLOYEES SICK LEAVE CREDIT FOR  
2 ACCUMULATED VACATION IN EXCESS OF THIRTY DAYS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. G.S. 126-8 reads as rewritten:

5 **"§ 126-8. Minimum leave granted State employees.**

6 The amount of vacation leave granted to each full-time State employee subject to the  
7 provisions of this Chapter shall be determined in accordance with a graduated scale  
8 established by the State Personnel Commission which shall allow the equivalent rate of  
9 not less than two weeks' vacation per calendar year, prorated monthly, cumulative to at  
10 least 30 days. Any State employee who has vacation leave in excess of the allowed  
11 accumulation shall have that leave converted to sick leave. Sick leave allowed as  
12 needed to such State employees shall be at a rate not less than 10 days for each calendar  
13 year, cumulative from year to year. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this  
14 section, no full-time State employee subject to the provisions of Chapter 126, as the  
15 same appears in the Cumulative Supplement to Volume 3B of the General Statutes, on  
16 May 23, 1973, shall be allowed less than the equivalent of three weeks' vacation per  
17 calendar year, cumulative to at least 30 days."

18 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
