A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE SCHOOL HEALTH
2 COORDINATORS TO ALL LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS
3 THAT ARE NOT CURRENTLY BEING SERVED BY STATE-FUNDED
4 SCHOOL HEALTH COORDINATORS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
8 Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of three million
9 three hundred twelve thousand two hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$3,312,288) for the
10 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of three million three hundred twelve thousand two
11 hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$3,312,288) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for salaries,
12 benefits, and related expenses to provide health coordinators to all local school
13 administrative units that are not currently being served by State-funded school health
14 coordinators, at a cost of forty-six thousand four dollars (\$46,004) a year for each
15 school health coordinator. These funds shall be allocated as provided in G.S. 115C-
16 81(e)(4).

17 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
