AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE SCHOOL HEALTH COORDINATORS TO ALL LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS THAT ARE NOT CURRENTLY BEING SERVED BY STATE-FUNDED SCHOOL HEALTH COORDINATORS.

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of three million three hundred twelve thousand two hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$3,312,288) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of three million three hundred twelve thousand two hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$3,312,288) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for salaries, benefits, and related expenses to provide health coordinators to all local school administrative units that are not currently being served by State-funded school health coordinators, at a cost of forty-six thousand four dollars (\$46,004) a year for each school health coordinator. These funds shall be allocated as provided in G.S. 115C-81(e)(4).

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
