A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ANSON COUNTY FOR CULTURAL
ACTIVITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Anson County the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

(1) \$5,000 to the Town of Lilesville for Fourth of July festivities; and

(2) \$70,000 to the Anson County Writers' Club for the acquisition of real and personal property and the construction of an outdoor theatre and appurtenant facilities for the outdoor drama "Sneydsborough: A Ripple in the River."

If the Anson County Writers' Club does not use the funds appropriated to it in this section within 12 months of the date of ratification, the funds shall revert to Anson County for Anson County Arts Council, Inc., to be used for cultural activities.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
