A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SENIOR CENTERS' MAINTENANCE,
RENOVATION, AND UPKEEP.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Aging, Department of Human Resources, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the maintenance, renovation, and upkeep of Senior Centers across the State. The Division shall allocate these funds based on need. No single center shall receive more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for this fiscal biennium from these funds.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
