A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR BLIND AT-RISK CHILDREN AT THE GOVERNOR MOREHEAD SCHOOL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Services for the Blind, Department of Human Resources, the sum of eight hundred thirty-eight thousand two hundred twenty-two dollars (\$838,222) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million two hundred twenty-four thousand seven hundred forty-six dollars (\$1,224,746) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for blind at-risk children at the Governor Morehead School. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

(4)	Outreach services for blind, visually impaired children	176,480	181,540
(5)	Statewide services for blind, visually impaired preschool children	336,997	725,117.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
