There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of 5 Services for the Blind, Department of Human Resources, the sum of eight hundred 6 thirty-eight thousand two hundred twenty-two dollars (\$838,222) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million two hundred twenty-four thousand seven hundred forty-8 six dollars (\$1,224,746) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for blind at-risk children at the 9 Governor Morehead School.
