A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS FOR
SUSPENDED STUDENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education, Department of Public Instruction, the sum of one million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated to local boards of education to be used exclusively for the establishment and operation of alternative educational programs for students suspended from school pursuant to G.S. 115C-391(c).

The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to assure that these programs provide quality instruction to suspended students and teach discipline and prevention of violent conduct.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
