The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$260,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$260,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the University of North Carolina Center for Public Television to provide all public schools in the State access to LEARNING LINK, a computer-based interactive communications system that features a variety of educational databases and information resources, message center and mail, and gateways to remote databases and bulletin boards, including the resources of the worldwide Internet.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
