A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PARTNERS OF WAKE COUNTY'S  
PROGRAM FOR TROUBLED YOUTH.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Partners of Wake County, Inc., the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to keep Partners' program for troubled youth operating. The Partners' program is the largest adult volunteer one-to-one mentorship program in North Carolina and was used by Governor Hunt as a model in setting up the Governor's One-on-One Programs. The Partners' program has had an influence on juvenile delinquency prevention in the State far beyond the number of at-risk children served in Wake County. Without these emergency operating funds, the Partners' program may cease to exist.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
