9	(a) There	e is established in the Department of Human Resources the Social
10	Workers' Educa	ation Loan Fund within the Office of the Secretary, to attract trained
11	social workers into public child welfare positions in all county departments of social	
12	services in the	State. The Secretary shall administer the Fund in concert with the
13	Department's responsibility for supervising public child welfare service training for the	
14	professional personnel rendering these services.	
15	<u>(b)</u> The S	Secretary shall ensure that all students receiving funds pursuant to this
16	section meet the following eligibility criteria:	
17	<u>(1)</u>	All students shall be enrolled in an institution of higher education in
18		North Carolina in an accredited bachelors of social work or masters of
19		social work program;
20	<u>(2)</u>	All students shall be residents of North Carolina. For purposes of this
21		section, residency shall be determined by the same standard as
22		residency for tuition purposes pursuant to G.S. 116-143.1;
23	<u>(3)</u>	All students shall enter into a legal agreement with the Department to
24		accept employment in public child welfare in exchange for receiving

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1		any funds, which agreement shall include stipulation that the student is
2		willing to accept employment in rural or other need-based counties;

4	(4	4) Any additional criteria that the Secretary considers necessary to
5		administer the program effectively.
6	<u>(c)</u> <u>T</u>	he Secretary shall ensure that the loan amounts are limited as follows:
7	<u>(1</u>	1) For a student pursuing a bachelors of social work degree, four
8		thousand dollars (\$4,000) per year for a maximum of four years; and
9	(2	2) For a student pursuing a masters of social work degree, five thousand
10		dollars (\$5,000) per year for a maximum of two years.
11	<u>(d)</u> <u>T</u>	he Secretary shall ensure that the following loan cancellations and
12	repayment s	schedules apply to all funds distributed pursuant to this section:
13	<u>(</u> ]	1) The individual who graduates with a bachelors of social work degree
14		or a masters of social work degree and who works for a public child
15		welfare agency in North Carolina shall have that amount of the loan
16		cancelled that is based on the amount of time employed and the
17		number of academic years funds were received. One full year of
18		employment shall cancel one academic year's loan, whether four
19		thousand dollars (\$4,000) or five thousand dollars (\$5,000);

21		or a masters of social work degree and who works in public child
22		welfare in North Carolina for the equivalent of the total number of
23		academic years funds were received shall have the entire loan
24		<u>cancelled;</u>
