A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS GRANTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year for senior citizens grants.

Sec. 2. In considering grant applications and making the grants funded by the appropriation in Section 1 of this act, the Department of Human Resources shall consider the following criteria:

- (1) The senior citizen population to be served by the potential recipient of any grant.
- (2) The local initiatives, in terms of funds collected from other sources, planning, volunteerism, etc., begun by the potential recipient of any grant in advance of the application for a grant.
- (3) A needs assessment for the services to be provided by a potential of any grant.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
