A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS GRANTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year for senior citizens grants.
Sec. 2. In considering grant applications and making the grants funded by the appropriation in Section 1 of this act, the Department of Human Resources shall consider the following criteria:
(1) The senior citizen population to be served by the potential recipient of any grant.
(2) The local initiatives, in terms of funds collected from other sources, planning, volunteerism, etc., begun by the potential recipient of any grant in advance of the application for a grant.
(3) A needs assessment for the services to be provided by a potential of any grant.
Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
