A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE HISTORICAL OUTDOOR  
DRAMA "PATHWAYS TO FREEDOM".

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Snow Camp Historical Drama Society, Inc., the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year for a new historical outdoor drama entitled "Pathways to Freedom". "Pathways to Freedom" will tell the story of the Quakers and their participation in the underground railroad, and will be the first outdoor drama dealing with black history.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
