1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH 2 COMMISSION TO STUDY THE EAST CAROLINA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE'S POTENTIAL SCOPE AND FOCUS FOR THE NEXT DECADE. 3 4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring: Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the East 5 Carolina University School of Medicine's potential scope and focus for the next decade. 6 This study may include: 7 Consideration of East Carolina University School of Medicine's 8 (1)historic mission of producing doctors to serve Eastern North Carolina, 9 with an emphasis on providing primary care physicians; 10 Consideration of the increasingly vital issue of access to health care 11 (2)and the increasing need to provide this access at the primary care level; 12 13 and 14 (3) Consideration of East Carolina University School of Medicine's growing role in producing physicians, physicians' extenders, and other 15 health care providers to determine whether this growing role is in 16 keeping with the School of Medicine's historic mission and with the 17 region's and the State's growing demand for health care access at the 18 primary care level. 19 20 Sec. 2. The Commission may make an interim report, including any 21 legislative proposals, to the 1993 General Assembly, Regular Session 1994, and may make a final report, including any legislative proposals, to the 1995 General Assembly. 22 Sec. 3. This act become effective July 1, 1993. 23
