17 18 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide adequate funding for the Crime Victim's Compensation Fund.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of forty-six thousand eight hundred dollars (\$46,800) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of forty-six thousand eight hundred dollars (\$46,800) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide access to the police information network for alcohol law enforcement officers.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
