3 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of one million dollars 4 5 (\$1,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to fund various coastal dredging projects.

6 Sec. 4. Beginning October 1, 1993, the Department shall make quarterly 7 reports on the use of these funds to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental 8 Operations, the Fiscal Research Division, and the Office of State Budget and 9 Management. Each report shall include:
