A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONNECT SIX UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA CAMPUSES TO THE MCNC NETWORK.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to MCNC (Microelectronics Center of North Carolina) the sum of two million four hundred eight thousand dollars (\$2,408,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two million eighteen thousand dollars (\$2,018,000) for the the 1994-95 fiscal year for the purchase and installation of capital equipment and the leasing of telephone circuits for connection of the MCNC Concert Telecommunications Network to the six University of North Carolina campuses that are not presently connected to the Network. The appropriations shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) Pembroke State University - \$795,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year;
- (2) Elizabeth City State University - \$878,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year;
- (3) Western Carolina University - \$735,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year.
- (4) Fayetteville State University - \$735,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year;
- (5) North Carolina Central University - \$728,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year;
- (5) University of North Carolina at Greensboro - \$555,000 for the 1994-95 fiscal year.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
