A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PUBLIC POLICY RESEARCH
SCHOLARS PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Governor's Institute on Alcohol and Substance Abuse, Inc., the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of fifty-one thousand dollars (\$51,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Public Policy Research Scholars Program. This project provides scholarships to North Carolina graduate students in the health sciences to do research on health-related substance abuse issues affecting public policy. The Governor's Institute on Alcohol and Substance Abuse, Inc., also provides technical assistance to scholars participating in the program for preparing presentations and written summaries of their work and publishes those summaries and commentaries.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
