A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AND FUND THE
REGIONAL GENETICS CENTER AT MEMORIAL MISSION HOSPITAL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of four hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$475,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to be used by Memorial Mission Medical Center, Inc., to establish the Western North Carolina Regional Genetics Center at Memorial Mission Hospital. The center will provide comprehensive genetic services to the citizens in the 16 western counties of North Carolina in Perinatal Region I.

Sec. 2. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used by Memorial Mission Medical Center, Inc., for operating the Western North Carolina Regional Genetics Center at Memorial Mission Hospital.

(b) This appropriation shall become part of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources' continuation budget for subsequent fiscal years.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
