A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR VARIOUS PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Community Development Corporation.

- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Credit Union Support Center.
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Microenterprise Program.
- Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for Rural Center Administration.
- Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for Opportunity Industrialization Centers.

- Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 1 2 Commerce the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal 3 year for NC Equity. 4 5
 - Sec. 7. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
