A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE  
FOR VARIOUS PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Community Development Corporation.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Credit Union Support Center.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Microenterprise Program.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for Rural Center Administration.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for Opportunity Industrialization Centers.

1           Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
2 Commerce the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal  
3 year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal  
4 year for NC Equity.

5           Sec. 7. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
