HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1496

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LATE S. R. "BUD" FOWLE, FORMER
2 MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, AND RECOGNIZING THE CITY
3 ON BEING NAMED AN ALL AMERICA CITY.

4 Whereas, the late S. R. "Bud" Fowle, former mayor of the City of
5 Washington, was a diligent servant to the City of Washington and was devoted to
6 improving the conditions of the City;

7 Whereas, the City of Washington in Beaufort County was recently honored
8 by the National Civic League as one of the 10 municipalities nationwide to receive its
9 All America City award; and

10 Whereas, the City of Washington was the only North Carolina city to win the
11 award this year; and

12 Whereas, the City of Washington exemplifies the American tradition of
13 people of different races and cultures living and working together successfully to
14 overcome its problems; and

15 Whereas, the City was recognized for its efforts to improve drinking water
16 quality after cancer-causing chemicals were found in the water supply; its projects to
17 provide low-cost housing; and its programs to promote cultural diversity;

18 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

19 Section 1. The General Assembly honors the life and memory of S. R.
20 "Bud" Fowle and expresses its deepest sympathy to his family. The General Assembly
21 also expresses its gratitude for his service to the people of the City of Washington.

22 Sec. 2. The General Assembly honors the City of Washington and its citizens
23 for receiving the National Civic League's All America City award and extends its pride

1 to the City and Beaufort County and its citizens for bringing national recognition to the
2 State of North Carolina.

3 Sec. 3. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution
4 to Floyd Brothers, the present Mayor of the City of Washington, and to the Chair of the
5 Beaufort County Board of County Commissioners.

6 Sec. 4. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
