A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A RESERVE FOR LIMITED-ENGLISH PROFICIENT STUDENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for a Reserve for Limited-English Proficient Students. Local school administrative units in which these students are enrolled shall apply to the State Board of Education for funds to enable the units to take appropriate action to rectify the language deficiencies of these students.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
