A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DEAF-BLIND INDEPENDENT LIVING SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Services for the Blind, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, to develop specialized services for people who are deaf and blind, to enable these people to become oriented to their environment, to access their community, and to communicate and acquire the skills needed to live and work as productive citizens.

The Division and the Division of Services for the Deaf and the Hard of Hearing shall coordinate the services needed by these individuals.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
