A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CRAVEN COUNTY TO ASSIST WITH
EXPENSES OF A PILOT PROJECT DESIGNED TO DEVELOP AND
EVALUATE ON-SITE ALTERNATIVE SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEMS
AND MANAGEMENT SCHEMES FOR THOSE SYSTEMS.**

Whereas, many soils are not suitable for conventional on-site sewage treatment systems, but are appropriate for alternative on-site sewage treatment systems; and

Whereas, continued growth in rural areas of the State is affected by the financial constraints of centralized sewage treatment systems and the lack of availability of alternative on-site sewage treatment systems; and

Whereas, the Craven County Innovative and Alternative Demonstration Program was established to address these problems by developing alternative on-site sewage treatment systems; Now, therefore,
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Craven County the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Craven County Innovative and Alternative Demonstration Program to develop and evaluate alternative on-site sewage treatment systems and proper management operating schemes for those systems that may be adopted statewide.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
