## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CRAVEN COUNTY TO ASSIST WITH
EXPENSES OF A PILOT PROJECT DESIGNED TO DEVELOP AND
EVALUATE ON-SITE ALTERNATIVE SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEMS
AND MANAGEMENT SCHEMES FOR THOSE SYSTEMS.

6 Whereas, many soils are not suitable for conventional on-site sewage 7 treatment systems, but are appropriate for alternative on-site sewage treatment systems; 8 and

9 Whereas, continued growth in rural areas of the State is affected by the 10 financial constraints of centralized sewage treatment systems and the lack of availability 11 of alternative on-site sewage treatment systems; and

12 Whereas, the Craven County Innovative and Alternative Demonstration 13 Program was established to address these problems by developing alternative on-site 14 sewage treatment systems; Now, therefore,

15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Craven County the 17 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the 18 Craven County Innovative and Alternative Demonstration Program to develop and 19 evaluate alternative on-site sewage treatment systems and proper management operating 20 schemes for those systems that may be adopted statewide.

21 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
