May 26, 1994 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of three hundred fifteen million three hundred fifty-four thousand seven hundred forty-one dollars (\$315,354,741) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for full implementation of the Basic Education Program. These funds shall be allocated as follows: Teachers to reduce class size in **(1)** grades K-3 \$65,124,605 Teachers to reduce class size in (2) grades 9-12 24,192,630 **Assistant Principals** 16,151,271 (3) Athletic Trainer Supplement 7,000 **(4)** Instructional Lab, Media, and (5) Clerical Assistants 64,973,456 **Instructional Support Personnel** 62,586,480 (6) **Teacher Assistants** 34,974,302 **(7)**
