A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ENABLING THE COUNTY OF DAVIDSON TO ESTABLISH AN AIRPORT AUTHORITY FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF AIRPORT FACILITIES IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIDSON FOR THE CITIZENS OF DAVIDSON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is hereby created the "Davidson County Airport Authority" (for brevity hereinafter referred to as the "Airport Authority" ), which shall be a body both corporate and politic, having the powers and jurisdiction hereinafter enumerated and such other and additional powers as shall be conferred upon it by future acts of the General Assembly.

Sec. 2. The Airport Authority shall consist of five members who shall be resident voters of Davidson County and who shall be appointed by the Davidson County Board of Commissioners, and who shall meet quarterly at a place determined by the Chairman of the Airport Authority. The Airport Authority shall consist of five members who shall be appointed to staggered terms of four years by the Davidson County Board of Commissioners. The initial terms of office of the members of the Airport Authority shall be as follows: two members to be appointed to a term of four years, three members to be appointed to a term of two years. Thereafter, all terms shall be four years. After the initial term, any member may be reappointed to two more successive terms, after which that member may not be reappointed to the Airport Authority except after the lapse of two years following the most recent term served. In the event the

1 Davidson County Board of Commissioners should appoint one of the members of that  
2 Board as a member of the Airport Authority, the membership shall not constitute double  
3 officeholding within the meaning of Article VI, Section 9 of the Constitution of North  
4 Carolina. Each of the members and their successors so appointed shall take and  
5 subscribe before the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners for the County of Davidson,  
6 an oath of office and file the same with the County Commissioners of Davidson County.  
7 Any member of the Airport Authority may be removed, for cause, by the Davidson  
8 County Board of Commissioners. The Davidson County Board of Commissioners,  
9 may, at the request of the Airport Authority, increase membership to no more than nine  
10 members or decrease the membership to no less than five members. The Davidson  
11 County Board of Commissioners shall consult with the Airport Authority in filling  
12 vacancies on the Airport Authority.

13           Sec. 3. The members shall, for the purpose of doing business, constitute a  
14 Board of Directors, which shall adopt suitable bylaws for its management. The  
15 members of the Board shall receive compensation or per diem by unanimous agreement  
16 of the Board of County Commissioners. Members shall be allowed and paid their actual  
17 traveling expenses incurred in transacting the business and at the instance of the Airport  
18 Authority.

19           Sec. 4. The Airport Authority shall constitute a body both corporate and  
20 politic, and may:

- 21           (1) Purchase, acquire, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip,  
22           improve, maintain, operate, and regulate the Davidson County Airport  
23           for the use of airplanes and other aircraft, and all facilities incidental to  
24           the operation of such airport, within the limits of Davidson County;  
25           and for any of such purposes, to purchase, acquire, own, hold, lease,  
26           and/or operate real or personal property;
- 27           (2) Purchase real or personal property;
- 28           (3) Sue or be sued in the name of the Airport Authority, make contracts  
29           necessary for the exercise of the powers of the Airport Authority, and  
30           acquire by purchase, lease, or otherwise, any existing lease, leasehold  
31           right, or other interest in any existing airport located in Davidson  
32           County;
- 33           (4) Charge and collect reasonable and adequate fees, royalties, rents, or  
34           other charges for the use of the property owned, leased, or otherwise  
35           controlled or operated by the Airport Authority or for services  
36           rendered in the operation thereof;
- 37           (5) Make all reasonable rules and regulations as it deems necessary for the  
38           proper maintenance, use, operation, and control of any airport or  
39           airport facilities owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by the Airport  
40           Authority; to provide penalties for the violation of such rules and  
41           regulations; provided the rules and regulations and penalties be not in  
42           conflict with the laws of the State of North Carolina and the rules and  
43           regulations of the Federal Aviation Administration;

- 1 (6) Sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of any property, real or personal,  
2 belonging to the Airport Authority, but no sale of real property shall be  
3 made without the approval of the Board of County Commissioners of  
4 Davidson County and the Federal Aviation Administration;
- 5 (7) Purchase such insurance as the Airport Authority shall deem  
6 necessary;
- 7 (8) Deposit or invest and reinvest any of its funds as provided by the Local  
8 Government Finance Act, as it may be amended from time to time, for  
9 the deposit or investment of unit funds;
- 10 (9) Operate, own, lease, control, regulate, or grant to others a lease; not to  
11 exceed 25 years, to operate on any airport premises, restaurants, snack  
12 bars, and vending machines, food and beverage dispensing outlets,  
13 rental car services, catering services, novelty shops, insurance sales,  
14 advertising media, merchandising outlets, motels, hotels, barber shops,  
15 automobile parking and storage facilities, automobile service stations,  
16 garage service facilities, motion pictures, personal service  
17 establishments, and all other types of facilities as may be directly or  
18 indirectly related to the maintenance and furnishing to the general  
19 public of a complete air terminal installation;
- 20 (10) Possess the same exemptions in respect to payment of taxes and  
21 license fees and be eligible for sales and use tax refunds to the same  
22 extent as provided for municipal corporations by the laws of the State  
23 of North Carolina;
- 24 (11) Issue revenue bonds pursuant to Article 5 of Chapter 159 of the  
25 General Statutes;
- 26 (12) Have all the same power and authority granted to cities and counties  
27 pursuant to Chapter 63 of the General Statutes; or
- 28 (13) Have a corporate seal which may be altered at will.

29 Sec. 5. Any lands acquired, owned, controlled, and occupied by the Airport  
30 Authority shall, and are hereby declared to be acquired, owned, controlled, and  
31 occupied for a public purpose.

32 Sec. 6. The Airport Authority shall make an annual report to the Davidson  
33 County Board of Commissioners setting forth in detail the operations and transactions  
34 conducted by it pursuant to this act. The Airport Authority shall be regarded as the  
35 corporate instrumentality and agent for Davidson County for the purpose of operating,  
36 maintaining, and developing airport facilities in Davidson County, but it shall not have  
37 the power to pledge the credit of Davidson County or any subdivision thereof, or to  
38 impose any obligation upon Davidson County or any subdivision thereof, except and  
39 when such power is expressly granted by statute.

40 Sec. 7. All rights and powers given and granted to the counties or  
41 municipalities by the statutes of North Carolina, which may now be in effect or enacted  
42 in the future relating to the development, regulation, and control of county airports and  
43 the regulation of aircraft, are vested in the Airport Authority, and Davidson County will

1 delegate its powers under those acts to the Airport Authority and the Airport Authority  
2 shall control, regulate, and provide for the development of aviation in Davidson County.

3           Sec. 8. The Airport Authority may employ agents, engineers, attorneys, and  
4 other persons whose services may be deemed by the Airport Authority to be necessary  
5 and useful in carrying out the provisions of this act.

6           Sec. 9. If any one or more sections, clauses, sentences, or parts of this act  
7 shall be adjudged invalid, that judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the  
8 remaining provisions thereof, but that judgment shall be confined in its operation to the  
9 specific provisions held invalid, and the inapplicability of invalidity of any section,  
10 clause, sentence, or part of this act in one or more instances or circumstances shall not  
11 be taken to affect or prejudice in any way to the applicability or validity in any other  
12 instance of that section, clause, sentence, or part.

13           Sec. 10. This act is effective upon ratification.
