Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Community Colleges the sum of one hundred eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$108,500) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide funds to Wilson Technical Community College to complete the cleanup of soil contaminated by petroleum products. This contamination is the direct result of operating the fire training center located at Wilson Technical Community College, which center has been available to and used by firemen from counties across the State.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
