**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE B.A.S.S. MASTERS CLASSIC  
FISHING TOURNAMENT.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Greensboro Sports Commission, Incorporated, the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to support the B.A.S.S. Masters Classic Tournament, the largest fishing tournament in the country, to be held July 25-30, 1994. The Classic is expected to enhance economic development and tourism throughout the Triad area, resulting in an economic impact estimated at twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) or more.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
