A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOLS
FOR THE DEAF TO MEET MINIMAL STANDARDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Services for the Deaf and the Hard of Hearing, the sum of four million two hundred eighty-eight thousand three hundred sixty-three dollars (\$4,288,363) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, to enable the North Carolina Schools for the Deaf to meet the minimum standards of the 1986 Presidential Commission on Education of the Deaf (COED) and to begin to meet the goals of a comprehensive plan developed with the assistance of the 1992 Task Force on Quality Assurance for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, which plan matches the goals and objectives of the Department of Human Resources' Strategic Plan. This comprehensive plan is the first such plan developed for the deaf and the hard of hearing anywhere in the United States.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
