A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY
2 COLLEGES FOR CAPE FEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S SHARE OF THE
3 COST IN CLEANING UP THE NEW HANOVER COUNTY BURN PIT AT THE
4 NEW HANOVER COUNTY AIRPORT.

6 Whereas, between 1968 and 1979, a site known as the New Hanover County
7 Burn Pit was used as a fire training practice ground; and

8 Whereas, as a result of this practice, the groundwater beneath the site has
9 become contaminated; and

10 Whereas, New Hanover County, the City of Wilmington, and Cape Fear
11 Community College are responsible for cleaning up the site; and

12 Whereas, Cape Fear Community College needs funds to cover its share of the
13 cost; Now, therefore,

14 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

15 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
16 Community Colleges the sum of three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) for the
17 1994-95 fiscal year for Cape Fear Community College's share of the cost in cleaning up
18 the New Hanover County Burn Pit located at New Hanover County Airport.

19 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
