A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO EXPAND THE REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS OF THE CENTER FOR IMPROVING MOUNTAIN LIVING AT WESTERN CAROLINA UNIVERSITY.

Whereas, current funding and limitations have limited the Regional Development Programs of the Center for Improving Mountain Living to respond to specialized, multifaceted constituent needs; and

Whereas, local governments in Western North Carolina need more specialized training, resource materials, and information pertinent to the region and designed to address unique challenges being confronted in the mountain communities; and

Whereas, minimal staffing resources and related support would help to expand the Regional Development Programs for delivery of local government training in response to the need for increased training capabilities; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Center for Improving Mountain Living at Western Carolina University to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$10,000 to increase the Regional Development Programs' capacity for travel, resource materials, and printing; and
- (2) \$30,000 for additional trainers for the Regional Development Programs.
- Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
