A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE "FIRST STEP" CAMPAIGN AND
2 HOT LINE, TO CONTINUE THE STATE'S EFFORTS TO REDUCE INFANT
3 MORTALITY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Maternal and Child Health,
8 the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for
9 the "FIRST STEP" campaign and hot line, to continue the State's efforts to reduce infant
10 mortality. This campaign is administered cooperatively by the Division of Maternal and
11 Child Health of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, the
12 Division of Medical Assistance of the Department of Human Resources, the Governor's
13 Commission on Reduction of Infant Mortality, the North Carolina Healthy Start
14 Foundation, and the March of Dimes Birth Defects Foundation.

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
