A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR COMPREHENSIVE ADOLESCENT HEALTH CENTERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Maternal and Child Health, the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to establish 10 additional comprehensive adolescent health centers in the State. The centers provide primary medical care, mental health services, and health promotion/disease and injury prevention education. The Department shall allocate funds for the establishment of the centers to local agencies through a competitive grant process.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
