A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF MINT HILL TO EXERCISE
2 EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION WITHIN ITS SPHERE OF
3 INFLUENCE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 161 of the Session Laws of 1991 reads as
7 rewritten:

8 "Section 1. Notwithstanding Section 12 of Chapter 860 of the 1971 Session Laws,
9 as amended by Chapter 966 of the 1983 Session Laws (Regular Session 1984), the
10 Towns of ~~Matthews, Mint Hill, Matthews~~ and Pineville and the City of Charlotte may
11 exercise the powers granted by Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes
12 within extraterritorial areas in Mecklenburg County not to exceed one mile of their
13 respective corporate limits, subject to the limitations set forth in this act.
14 Notwithstanding Section 12 of Chapter 860 of the 1971 Session Laws, as amended by
15 Chapter 966 of the 1983 Session Laws (Regular Session 1984), the Town of Mint Hill
16 may exercise in Mecklenburg County the powers granted by Article 19 of Chapter 160A
17 of the General Statutes within the sphere of influence as defined by the annexation
18 agreement described in Chapter 953 of the Sessions Laws of 1983, subject to the
19 limitations set forth in this act."

20 Sec. 2. Ordinances authorized under this act may be adopted as provided by
21 law at any time after ratification of this act, but may not become effective prior to
22 January 1, 1994.

23 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
