A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FULL FAITH AND CREDIT TO OUT-OF-STATE
PATERNITY DETERMINATIONS REGARDLESS OF METHOD OF
ESTABLISHMENT AS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW AND NEEDED TO
PREVENT LOSS OF FEDERAL FUNDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 110-132 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(c) Any paternity determination made by another state in accordance with the laws of that state shall be entitled to full faith and credit in this State, provided that this determination constitutes a legal paternity establishment in the other state regardless of the method used for determining paternity."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
