A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PROCESS LEADERSHIP  
2 TRAINING PROGRAM AT FAYETTEVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY.

3       Whereas, various organizations from communities throughout the State are  
4 being trained at Fayetteville State University in local strategic planning; and

5       Whereas, Fayetteville State University is involved in the support of local  
6 strategic planning in the Cumberland County area through the MetroVisions Program;  
7 and

8       Whereas, local strategic planning includes the innovative concept of process  
9 leadership that has been developed by many local leaders throughout the State of North  
10 Carolina and is being taught at Fayetteville State University; and

11       Whereas, local community-based strategic planning can provide effective  
12 leaders trained to build consensus on important issues of community concern; and

13       Whereas, funds are needed to provide effective follow-through to assure that  
14 comprehensive results are facilitated by local strategic planning; Now, therefore,  
15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16       Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
17 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifty thousand dollars  
18 (\$50,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fund the Process Leadership Training Program  
19 at Fayetteville State University, a program established to train process leaders in North  
20 Carolina in local strategic planning.

21       Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
